

Taekwondo BC Directors & Officers Roles and Responsibilities

Officers At a Glance

- President: CEO & chair of meetings.
- VP 1: Steps in for President.
- VP 2: Steps in for VP 1 and/or President.
- Secretary: Records minutes & keeps member registry.
- Treasurer: Manages finances, reports to Board & AGM.

Financial Stewardship

- Approve budgets & financial statements.
- Expenses >\$1000 need Board pre-approval.
- Directors unpaid; reimbursed for reasonable expenses.
- Ensure funds directly support sport growth & athlete development.

Roles & Duties of the Board

- Supervise PSO operations, uphold bylaws, protect integrity of Taekwondo in BC.
- Set safe sport, insurance, & compliance policies.
- Declare conflicts; directors abstain from conflicted votes.
- Develop and oversee long-term strategic plans to grow Taekwondo BC and uphold standards consistent with Taekwondo Canada
- Risk Management and Compliance

 oversee adherence to insurance, criminal record checks, safe sport policies, and ensure the PSO meets provincial and federal sport regulations
- Committees: Masters, Awards & Disciplinary.



Best Practices for PSOs

- Director training on governance & safe sport.
- Safe Sport Leadership champion policies on harassment
- prevention, athlete safety and ethical coaching
 - No proxy voting each delegate votes directly.
 - Clear succession planning.
 - Transparency & regular reporting build trust.
