<b>Divisions :</b>	WT Black Belt Kyorugi - Black Belts born from 2011 and before will be competing with the current WT rules (head kicks allowed) Youth Black Belt (11 years old and under) Kyorgui & Colour Belt Kyorugi - no head kicks allowed WT Black Belt Poomsae - Black Belts born from 2011 and before will be competing with the current WT Rules. Categories: Recognized - (Individual, Pairs, Teams), Freestyle (Individual, Pairs, Mixed Teams) <b>IMPORTANT: *Please note that this Master's Cup will be held as the official Team Trials for our Senior Divisions. 1st place winners will receive provincial funding that goes towards the 2024 Canadian Nationals. Competitors born from 2007 and before will be eligible to register for the senior division.</b> <b>**Competitors born in 2007 have the option to compete at the Junior Division, or Senior Division, or BOTH in this competition. By choosing to compete in the Senior Division, the athlete automatically acknowledges and accepts all risks and potential injuries involved in competing against athletes that are 17 years of age and older.</b>
